Proposition 1	Housing Affordability Bonds <i>(Legislative Statute)</i> Authorizes bonds for housing affordability programs to support low- and middle-income housing development.	
Proposition 2	State Rainy Day Fund <i>(Legislative Constitutional Amendment)</i> Increases the limit on deposits into the state's budget stabilization reserve (Rainy Day Fund).	
Proposition 3	High-Income Tax Extension for Schools & Healthcare <i>(Initiative Constitutional Amendment)</i> Provides permanent funding for K-12 schools and healthcare by extending taxes on high earners.	
Proposition 4	Public Financing of Election Campaigns <i>(Legislative Statute)</i> Repeals existing prohibitions against public funding of political campaigns in California.	
Proposition 5	Recall Election Process Reform <i>(Legislative Constitutional Amendment)</i> Modifies procedures and timelines for recall elections of statewide officers.	
Proposition 37	Middle-Income Homebuyer Loan Program <i>(Initiative Statute)</i> Creates a second state-backed loan program providing low-cost mortgages to middle-income buyers of qualifying new homes.

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Proposition 38	Immunology Medical Research Bonds <i>(Initiative Statute)</i> Authorizes state general obligation bonds to fund scientific and clinical immunology medical research.	
Proposition 39	Government-Issued Voter Identification Requirement <i>(Initiative Constitutional Amendment)</i> Prohibits citizens from voting unless they present valid government-issued photo identification.	
Proposition 40	One-Time Wealth Tax on Billionaires <i>(Initiative Constitutional Amendment & Statute)</i> Imposes a one-time tax on certain ultra-high-net-worth taxpayers to generate revenue for state programs.	
Proposition 41	State Tax Spending Limits & Audits <i>(Initiative Constitutional Amendment)</i> Prohibits new state taxes that bypass state spending limits and requires mandatory audits for new special tax revenue.	
Proposition 42	Personal Property Tax Prohibition <i>(Initiative Constitutional Amendment)</i> Prohibits new state personal property taxes and places restrictions on retroactive tax measures.	
Proposition 43	Local Government Revenue Voting Thresholds <i>(Legislative Constitutional Amendment)</i> Modifies limits on local voter approval requirements to raise revenues for local public services.	
Proposition 44	Community Health Clinic Spending Requirements <i>(Initiative Statute)</i> Requires non-profit safety-net health clinics to allocate at least 90% of revenues directly to program services and patient care.	
Proposition 45	Environmental Review Modification <i>(Initiative Statute)</i> Modifies environmental review requirements (CEQA) to streamline development for designated housing and infrastructure projects.
